



Senator Bob Wieckowski

Senator Bob Wieckowski was elected on Nov. 4, 2014 and represents the 10th Senate District in the California State Legislature. The district stretches from southern Alameda County into Santa Clara County.

Mr. Wieckowski serves as chair of the Environmental Quality Committee. He is also a member of the Senate committees on Business, Professions and Economic Development; Insurance; Judiciary; and Transportation and Housing.

In his first four years in office, Senator Wieckowski passed 35 bills that were signed into law by Governor Brown. Reflecting his collaborative style, most of these bills were approved with strong, bipartisan support.

He has launched the Made in California Jobs Initiative to expand California manufacturing, invest in biotechnology research, and fight for small businesses.

Mr. Wieckowski is a small business owner and a bankruptcy attorney. He has helped hundreds of families and seniors persevere through economic hardship, keep their homes and live with dignity. He received his B.A. from the University of California and his J.D. from Santa Clara University Law School.
